



Disposal Policy

Aim

The aim of this policy is to ensure that any unidentified goods left in FreightEx's possession for an extended length of time follows a correct protocol for disposal.

Inspection

Without limiting any provisions in FreightEx's Standard Terms & Conditions of Contract, prior to disposing of the unidentified goods in accordance with this policy;

- FreightEx will attempt to identify correct delivery details, by identity of Sender, Receiver, or any other third party of these goods.
- FreightEx will attempt to check any markings on items and/or consignment.
- FreightEx will attempt to open goods and/or any paperwork from packaging, to make an inspection.

Disposal

Goods that have been held for a period of three months or greater and are unidentified may be disposed of by in any way FreightEx deems to be appropriate.

This may include the disposal of goods by the following means;

- Private sale or public auction of all or any part of the goods.
- Destruction or abandonment of all or any part of the goods.

FreightEx may retain any monies from the above disposal of the unidentified goods.
